Tripping Over the Living Stone

Here we are coming around the final bend of "Lent" and can see the finish line, or maybe I should say beginning line. For in Christ every day we are renewed in heart, mind and spirit because by GRACE we are loved and forgiven. In this grace we can start each day new, knowing that the tomb of Lent is the Empty Tomb of Easter!

Of course, by the time you receive this for April, Easter celebration will be upon us. April 9th. Keep your faith footing sure and focused because the risen Christ who walks with you. Not just a day of celebration but a lifetime of hope and God's peace that will surround you. Come to Him that "living stone."

I am reminded of a passage from 1 Peter 2: 4-7:

⁴Come to him, a living stone, though rejected by mortals yet

chosen and precious in God's sight, and ⁵ like living stones let yourselves be built into a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ⁶ For it stands in scripture: "See, I am laying in Zion a stone,

a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame." ⁷ This honor, then, is for you who believe, but for those who do not believe, "The stone that the builders rejected

has become the very head of the corner," 8 and "A stone that makes them stumble

and a rock that makes them fall."

Believe it or not, when I am walking the track at the Riverplex, smooth as can be, my foot catches and I stumble! Believe it or not, a rug in the house, a crack in the sidewalk and you can add more, I stumble! This is simply to say, Jesus is the living stone and we

need to keep our eyes on Him and "watch where we are walking!"

Sometimes we can stumble in our hearts when we think we KNOW where we are going in faith and life. Rather than focusing upon the grace given, we contemplate our own foundation rather than building on the cornerstone of Jesus.

God has "called you out of darkness into his marvelous light." We are God's chosen and loved people.

Come and be with us this Easter and rejoice in the living cornerstone that we can in confidence, build upon.

Death Doesn't Win

In the final hours of 2021, a wildfire near Boulder, Colorado, destroyed 1,000 homes, including one belonging to Pastor Bill Stephens. His family, out of town at the time, lost all their possessions. After months of feeling buried in debris, insurance paperwork and mourning, Stephens decided that Easter 2022 would mark a fresh start.

During worship that morning, the pastor shared a photo of vibrant daffodils emerging on his charred property. Burned remnants were visible in the background, just as Easter's backdrop includes the pain and death of Good Friday. But the empty tomb in Easter's foreground means death won't win, reminded Stephens. Even when earthly life "isn't all daffodils," we have hope and eternal life through Jesus.

Easter reveals that God will "give us the joy, and it's going to be in the heart of pain that we go through as well," added the pastor. "And that just makes me draw closer to God."
