Lament as an Act of Faith

I don't know about you, but I find that I cannot be "happy" or all things going well – all the time! Then what happens? Lament.

The first thing that comes to my mind is Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane praying: Mark 14:35-36 And going a little farther, he threw himself on the ground and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him. He said, "Abba," Father, for you all things are possible; remove this cup from me; yet, not what I want, but what you want."

Probably and most often not facing the death that Jesus was praying about, but maybe it felt like a "death" in facing health issues, life issues, relationship issues, loneliness issues and I know you can name more.

Sometimes we ask the heartfelt question: "How long, O Lord? Will you utterly forget me?" (Psalm 13:2). Notice that Jesus is still praying and connected to God even in these times. From the cross..."My God, my God,

why have you forsaken me?" And yet, "into your hands I give my Spirit" says Jesus from the cross.

Understand clearly that doubt and anguish are not opposed to faith: DESPAIR is. St. Paul reminds us that everyone might be "perplexed, but not driven to despair." (2 Corinthians 4:8)

We are journeying through Lent and on our Wednesday worship time we will explore the various facets of "Lament." Journeying toward the idea that "lament" is not a failure of faith, but an act of faith. Jesus was praying to God and never stopped that connection.

Think about this...Over one third (50 or so) of the psalms are laments. Jesus often went off to pray, to stay connected with OUR Heavenly Father. Remember again in the Garden of Gethsemane Jesus took Peter, James and John and began to be distressed and agitated...stay with me, he said and keep awake. Of course, they fell asleep. Sometimes I feel like "lament" is difficult but helpful when others can bring presence and support.

Sometimes I may feel like I'm at the end of the proverbial "rope." It helps to stay connected to one another and most of all that God is there for you! Jesus trusted all he was and will be for us, to God.

On Wednesday, February 21 in our evening worship we read from Lamentations 3:22-24 The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases, his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. "The Lord is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in him."

If you need prayers...call. If you can come and be with us either on Wednesdays or Sundays...support is here. Remember again...Lament is not a failure of faith, but an act of faith. As in the Garden of Gethsemane, we cry out to our God.

Join us for the celebration at worship and stay for the coffee fellowship!







There will be a Coffee Fellowship after the Easter worship service. Sign up on one of the sheets posted on the bulletin board.
