It is obvious that the news, our country, the world, seems to lean/ reside more lately in hate, mistrust, diminishing the human spirit and surely not connecting with God who is

From Luther's explanation to the First Article of the Apostles' Creed, it says: "He provides me with all I need from day to day. God also protects me in time of danger. All this he does out of fatherly (motherly) divine goodness, though I do not deserve it. Therefore, I surely ought to thank and praise, serve and obey him."

To thank him is to reflect him in our daily living with and around each other! It would seem we are too busy about ourselves and pushing others who are different than us, "away." We can be different and still help pull someone out of a car crash and yet some would let the person suffer.

Psalm 107:8-9 "Let them thank the Lord for his steadfast love, for his wonderful works to human kind. For He satisfies the thirsty, and the hungry he fills with good things." As children of God, loved by God, shouldn't we reflect this steadfast love and put anger and resentment aside?

We are also **hosting CWU on Friday, May 10** at 10:00 a.m. All church ladies are invited.


The Mary Martha Circle will *not be meeting in June, July, or August,* but we will be <u>providing dinner to the Salvation Army Transitional Center in July.</u>
